The Opening Rally - Sunday, 6th February

Our opening rally for 2011 will be held in the picnic grounds of the Woronora Dam. The turn off to the dam is located on the Old Princes Highway (do not take the express way) 2.4 miles south of the overpass at Waterfall. The dam is located 4.4 miles in off the Old Princes Highway on a sealed road. There is ample parking for our cars and shade is provided by an abundance of trees as well as shelter sheds. It is advisable to bring your fold up chairs. There are barbecue facilities available and an amenities block near to where we will be. You will find this location will provide an ideal setting for our first event of the year and you will need to bring a picnic or barbecue lunch with you as well some cool refreshments. Please arrive at the grounds by 10.30am and you will be directed by one of the Committee to the area we have selected for the venue.

For those who would like a little more driving to the event, can I suggest to meet in the car park on the southern side of the weir at Audley in the Royal National Park. Tell the Ranger at the entry booth as you enter the park that you are "travelling through" and accordingly you will not pay any fee. Please meet at the car park at 9am and you will be issued with instructions to take a picturesque drive through the park to Bald Hill above Stanwell Park where you will then travel back to the Princes Highway and to the entrance of the dam.
