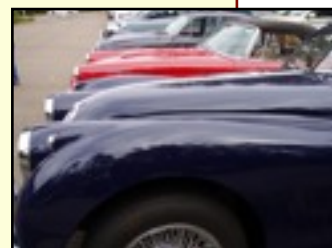
These events take a great deal of organising so please give it your support. Everyone who went last year had a great time and, as well, it's a good drive down to Cootamundra.
